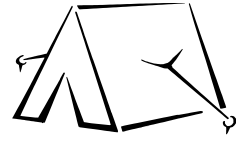


Primitive Group Camp

Blennerhassett Island Historical State Park



Blennerhassett Island offers primitive camping for groups, such as Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, 4-H, church youth group or corporate retreat. To camp on the island arrangements must be made in advance. Camping on the island requires authorization from the park superintendent in a designated area.

How do I reserve the campsite?

The primitive campsite is advanced reservation only. The camping fee is \$50 per night for a maximum of 5-75 guests.

How do I get to the Island?

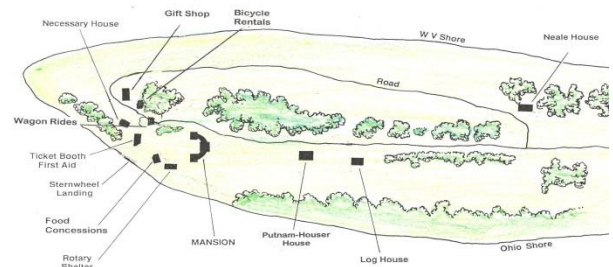
Transportation to the island is by general admission sternwheeler tickets or private boat.

- We recommend the Island Belle Sternwheeler and the fee is \$5 per youth and youth leader; \$9 parents.
- For Operating Hours contact the park office or visit the Operating Tab.
- Private boat: You can provide your own private boat for transportation to the island. Please call the park office for information about docking areas.

Where is the campsite located?

The campsite is located approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ of mile from the sternwheeler landing, behind the Neale house, and campers are expected to walk to the campsite area.

Park staff will provide you with one pickup truck load to the site upon arrival and one pickup truck load to the boat on departure to transport your equipment only.



What is included with the primitive camping fee?

- Firewood will be provided
- Fire rings (3)
- Picnic tables (4)
- Trash cans and liners are provided
- Port-A-Johns – one at the campsite
- Water is available nearby
- Shower facilities and electrical hookups are not available
- Electrical hookups are not available in the camping area

General Information

- Please bring first aid supplies, bug spray, sunscreen, etc.
- Fishing is permitted; applicable licenses required
- Campsites must be kept neat; trash placed in appropriate containers
- Camping is in the designated area only
- No object may be driven into any tree, rock, shrub, sign, building or other object in the campground
- Trenching or digging is prohibited
- Weapons, firearms, bow & arrows are not permitted
- No motorized vehicles (4 wheelers, etc.); however, bicycles are permitted
- Alcohol is prohibited
- Feeding and harassing wildlife is prohibited

Payment

Payment may be made by check, cash, credit card (please use only one form of payment.)

Camping fee along with final passenger count (if applicable with sternwheeler use) is due 72 hours or before the scheduled camping date.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations more than 72 hours prior to the scheduled camping date will receive full refund or may be applied to a another available date in the current season.
